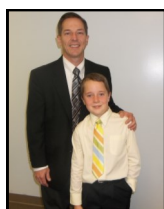

Big Phae

What it takes to stay on the road

To maintain our office in the motorhome, it takes internet and cell phone access. We have limped along this first year with a limited Verizon data plan while wifi in churches and campgrounds was usually weak at best. Without these, we cannot download files, videos, audios, skype, etc..

RVers recommend 2 solutions:

- 1) Increasing the Verizon data plan (in our case from 6 to 10 GB for an extra \$20/mo. We will likely do this esp. when Bill & Marcia go to the Philippines.
- 2) Installing WifiRanger Sky, a device that strengthens wifi signals and receives them within 1/2 mile away. We had this installed (\$550) in Sept.

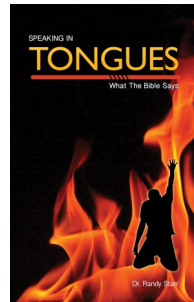
You must have on the road is a refrigerator. Ours quit upon arrival in Brogue. After 5 trips to the RV shop, it's fixed. Of the \$2900 it took to fix it, our extended warranty paid \$1850! To God be the Glory!
